


Iowa Afterschool Alliance's Out of School Time Programs

As of November of 2015, 312 out-of-school time sites across lowa have listed their program on the IAA directory. The sites provide out-of-school time programming in a variety of settings including schools and community-based organizations. The following data reflects only the programs in the directory to date. "STEM programs" are those that indicated that they provide STEM activities in their program. "No STEM programs" are those that did not indicate any STEM offerings.

Out of School time programs serve a wide variety of grade levels. The number of sites serving Pre-K through high school is as follows:

STEM Programs as Compared to No STEM Programs by Grade Levels Served




STEM and No STEM Programming by Type of Provider

STEM Offerings by Site Type


